# New from New Brunswick

There is not much news from our Region. There are so few of us exhibiting in this area.

We do have some fairly new 'enthusiasts' in the persons of Roxanne Ogden and Bonnie O'Brien. They now have their second cocker from Jean DeWolfe, and have had some exciting wins in the show ring over the last year or so. They also breed and show Dachies and Shelties.

We had a cocker litter two in the Fall from Can. Ch. Marsuvica's Amazing Dawg (Angelica) and Can. Ch. Lurians Boomerang (Matt).

I have just bred Taka (Can. Ch. Marsuvica's Let's Taka Chance). Her sire and dam are Am. Ch. Kaplar's Total Eclipse and Can. Ch. Marsuvica's Autumn Splendor, respectively. The sire of the expected litter is Can. Ch. Lurians Calowa's Legacy Of Gold (Legacy). We await the 'excitement' at the end of March.

That's about it from here. We struggle with the fall-out from the 'cropping, docking and dewclaw removal' scenario. Confusion and frustration remain as we try to manage with the NB CVMA regulation.

Also, we are now dealing with the new NB Pet Establishment Regulations (June 1, 2010) which require an annual Kennel License by everyone in the province who breeds a litter of pups. The licensing is being administered by the NB SPCA. The role-out has been nothing but confusing, and is 'on hold' as we (purebred dog breeders) try to help with some very necessary changes. The Kennel License now costs \$250.00, whereas the previous fee was \$100.00, and was administered by each municipality. All responsibility was turned over to the provincial requirements. This is separate from 'animal control' which is still the responsibility of the various municipalities, and is another part of the confusion.
