Bailey started his obedience career in February 1997 at the age of 1-1/2 years, when he earned his CKC Companion Dog (CD) title in one weekend. The following year, in February 1998, Bailey earned his CKC Companion Dog Excellent title in one weekend, with placements each trial. That year he was also ranked the #2 American Cocker Spaniel in Canada for Obedience. 1999 was a training year but Bailey still trialed occasionally and was ranked the #1 American Cocker Spaniel in Canada for Obedience. In 2000 we started our quest for Bailey's Utility or Obedience Trial Champion title. Again, we started in February and managed to complete this task in just 11 trials, finishing in June of that year, just one week past Bailey's 5th birthday. That year, Bailey also was ranked the #4 American Cocker Spaniel in Canada for Obedience.

Later that same year we headed off to the U.S. where Bailey earned his American Companion Dog title. He has also earned his American Companion Dog Excellent title with 2 first placements and a 4th - all of which were earned at all-breed events.

Bailey was honoured by the K-W Kennel Club (an all-breed club) as their Top Obedience Dog for the year 2000.

Agility & Rally Obedience have now become our venue of choice & Bailey has earned, to date, agility titles in the following organizations: CKC, AKC, Agility Association of Canada (AAC); and North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC). In Rally Obedience, Bailey has achieved all three standard levels, being the first American Cocker Spaniel in Canada to receive the Rally Excellent Magna Cum Laude title from the Canadian Association of Rally Obedience (CARO).

Even at 11 years of age, Bailey is not slowing down - we continue to run successfully in agility and look forward to continuing on with AKC & CKC Rally Obedience.

Bailey truly is one in a million and I believe he is one of the best representatives of the versatility of our breed. I am proud & honoured to call him my very best friend.
